



## WATERCOLOR SUPPLY LIST



### PAPER

- 140lb. cold-pressed acid-free watercolor paper ... block or pad
- If using a pad you will also need:
- 1" or ¾" masking tape

### PAINT

Tube paint only! ..(recommended)

Required colors and/or substitutions:

- Alizarin Crimson or Rose Madder
- Cadmium Red medium
- Prussian Blue
- Ultramarine Blue
- Cerulean Blue
- Raw Sienna
- Burnt Sienna
- Burnt Umber
- Gamboge or Quinoxidine Yellow (also called Golden Lake )
- Sap Green or Hookers Green
- Dioxazine Violet (also called Winsor Violet)
- Two optional colors that excite you!
- (NO whites, grays or blacks)

### BRUSHES

(Some advice... **Pay for good brushes. You will never regret it!** )

- 1 large flat wash brush , minimum of 1½" wide
- 1 small round detail brush #0 or #00
- 1 medium-sized (maybe a #8) round sable brush , must come to a nice point
- 2 flat sable brushes , one small (≈½"), one larger(at least 1")
- 1 large round brush , which also comes to a nice point when wet.

### ADDITIONAL ITEMS

- A pallet which is big enough to lay out all your colors in side wells and also has room to mix colors
- Paper towels

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
